New Mass Weekday Mass Schedule! Sacred Heart has daily Traditional Latin Mass at 9:00 a.m. Confession is heard a half an hour before Mass Monday-Friday. There is a Holy Hour following Mass on Saturday when Confession is also heard. On Tuesday's after Mass, we pray the Perpetual Novena of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal. Beginning in October, there will be adult catechism following Mass on Wednesdays in the Rectory. There will be an opportunity for children's catechism and evening adult catechism on Tuesdays at Old St. Mary's, also beginning in October. Please take advantage of this opportunity for daily Mass and devotions!

FROM THE PASTOR

This upcoming week, we will be privileged to host the relics of St. Pio of Pietrelcina at both parishes. The relics will visit Old St. Mary's on Friday, September 23. The evening will begin with a presentation in Fr. Felten Hall, followed by Mass in the Church at 7:00 p.m. with veneration of the relics and a procession. The relics will then visit Sacred Heart on Sunday, September 25. The relics will be available for veneration after each Mass, with presentations occurring in the Sacristy and Rectory after both Masses. Padre Gian Maria DiGiorgio, a Friar from the Friary where Padre Pio lived, will be accompanying the relics and be preaching. May God Bless each of you in your work, and please continue to pray for an increase in vocations to the priesthood and the religious life each day.
