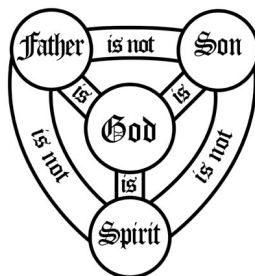
FROM THE PASTOR

Please mark down now a special Mass and social for our Titular Feast on June 23, the Feast of the Sacred Heart. A titular feast is simply the feast of the title that a parish holds. For us, that is the Sacred Heart. A Solemn Traditional Latin Mass - a Mass with a celebrant, a deacon, and a subdeacon – will be held at 7:00 p.m. followed by a social in the parish hall. We will repeat the Feast of the Sacred Heart on the following Sunday at both the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses so that all have the opportunity to celebrate the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Please try to make it to the Solemn Mass on Friday, June 23, even if you are unfamiliar with the Latin Mass. This is a great opportunity to meet the various people in the parish!

A few months ago, we were blessed to receive a bequest from someone who left the parish in their will worth over \$60,000. We have been lucky enough to not have to rely on bequests as part of our usual operating expenses. However, bequests are an important source of revenue to the parish. These monies are generally placed into the renovation fund, unless otherwise specified, which allow us to do capital improvements to the Church building when required. This can be a life saver as we try to maintain these historic buildings. Old St. Mary's recently had a bell tower project, to repair some sandstone, which cost over \$100,000. Had a number of bequests not been given to the parish, I would have had to ask the parishioners to bear the burden of this cost.

This is important, because we do try not to burden you with many requests for financial support, beyond the Sunday collection. If you have not already, please be sure to remember Sacred Heart, as well as the Oratory, in your will. Both are important to the continued operation of our parish. Without maintaining the Church building, this historic building would quickly fall into disrepair. Though it is expensive to keep the building up, it is well worth the labor, effort, and cost. Without maintaining the Oratory, we would not be able to keep up the priests who look after our spiritual needs. In a few years we will number five priests, increasing the amount of things we can do at Sacred Heart and bringing new vitality to the parish. With the Oratory, Sacred Heart has a secure future so long as you remain committed to it. The question for both Sacred Heart and Old St. Mary's isn't "will we get another priest assigned here?" Or even "will have to continue to share a priest?" The question for both Sacred Heart and Old St. Mary's is "how many priests will be assigned here in the future?" So please be generous, either in your giving now, or in your will, to each. So that we continue to leave a faithfully and secure parish to our future generations! Have a blessed week ahead!
