FROM THE PASTOR

This is just a reminder that during October we keep the October Count. Please be sure to attend Mass at Sacred Heart Church each Sunday, bringing a neighbor or friend with you. You are each our greatest ambassadors to draw others to our parish, so please be good ambassadors!

Please also try to make it to the Annual Banquet for the Oratory on Monday, October 30. This is our only major fund raiser. Next Sunday will be a collection for our seminarians, your future Priests. Which I will explain why in the coming paragraphs. So please be generous for this collection and come to the Banquet if possible!

Please find with the bulletin today a financial report about the state of the parish. This includes the previous two years' income and expenses, and the projected expenses for this fiscal year. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me in the parish office. The financial state of the parish is good, but I ask for your continued financial support. If you could consider an increase of 3% to 5%, that would help with the continued mission of the parish. If you haven't written Sacred Heart into your will, please consider doing us. Often, these bequests are what enable parishes to make capital improvements and ensure the continued financial health of the overall parish. I thank each of you for what you have done thus far for Sacred Heart.

The past two years have seen a lot of change. With Fr. Earl departing to begin a new position in Washington DC, the opening of Our Lady of Lourdes parish in Park Hills, and the Oratory coming to Sacred Heart. I thank each of you for your continued commitment to Sacred Heart and to those who were extraordinarily helpful to me during the transition. Sacred Heart has gotten a little smaller during these many changes, but I also am also very edified by those who have been so committed to the parish all of these years. Your devotion keeps Sacred Heart going. Your presence is what allowed the Oratory to take on the extra work of an additional parish, so thank you!

With that said, the financial health of the parish is only one aspect of what we do here. In some ways, it is the least important in comparison to the Sacramental and Evangelical mission left to us by Christ Himself. Over this past year, we have had four baptisms, five First Holy Communions, and three parishioner weddings. In your charity, please remember in your prayers the souls of Ronald Newell, Hattie Cowns, Mary Backsman, and Daniel McCullough who passed away this past year. Remember them, and all our faithfully departed parishioners, in your prayers each day.

This past year saw the establishment of the Cincinnati Oratory by the Holy Father on March 19. This act will ensure a flow of priests for Sacred Heart for generations to come. With this I also ask for your financial support of the Oratory, especially with the education of our seminarians. These seminarians, currently Brothers Brent and Henry, are your future priests. The Archdiocese does not contribute to their education costs, which when all calculated is over \$30,000 per seminarian per year. This is a huge expense, but the prospects of future priests are well worth the sacrifice and expense. Without these seminarians, there would be no future priests for the Oratory and consequently our parish.

Thank you again for all you do for Sacred Heart. Please remember the importance of being with us each week, and try to attend daily Mass, Adoration, devotions as often as you can. Remember to frequent the confessional, so that at any moment we are ready to make an account of lives to God. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to let me know.
