We commemorated the 100th Anniversary of Fatima, and our third Annual Men's Holy Name Eucharistic Procession. Today is the Italian Dinner at Sacred Heart and we welcome the Germainia Society to Old St. Mary's. The Fundraising Banquet for the Oratory, on Monday, October 30.

I now take this opportunity to publicly thank everyone who helped make each of these events, and so many other things not mentioned, possible. From August 8-12, 2018, the Oratory, Old St. Mary's, and Sacred Heart will host a Sacred Music Retreat for scholas and choirs.
