From the Pastor

Laudetur Jesus Christus! Gelobt sei Jesus Christus! Sia lodato Gesù Cristo! Praised be Jesus Christ!

While I was still in the seminary, it was Fr. William Fitzgerald, O.Praem. who first introduced me to this prayer, and I have found it a worthwhile Advent practice ever since. The Feast of St. Andrew is November 30, and so it has taken its name from him, on whose feast this novena prayer begins. If one recites it fifteen times per day, for a particular intention, we place our hope that God will hear our prayers. The Novena runs through Christmas Eve. This is how the prayer goes:

Hail and blessed be the hour and moment
In which the Son of God was born
Of the most pure Virgin Mary,
at midnight, in Bethlehem,
in the piercing cold.
In that hour vouchsafe,
I beseech Thee, O my God,
to hear my prayer and grant my desires,
[here mention your request]
through the merits of Our Saviour Jesus Christ,
and of His blessed Mother.
Amen.

I encourage everyone to use this Novena during this Advent. Please pray for our Church, our Nation, our Parish, and our Families. May God Bless you in this week ahead! – Fr. Jon-Paul
