A note from our Schola:

The Oratorian Community, through both Sacred Heart and Old St. Mary's, is hosting a Sacred Music Retreat for liturgical musicians that will run in August this year. This particular retreat is centered around the liturgy and music associated with the Extraordinary Form, will feature internationally recognized musicians to assist in developing musical growth, as well as one or more clerics to act in the capacity of a retreat master. The retreat will address the spirituality inherent in participating in a parish choir; the desire to seek the glory of God through music and to draw souls to Christ. It will be held at the St. Anne Retreat Center in Melbourne, KY, with accommodations for up to 120 participants. In the preliminary planning stages, interest has been expressed in attending this retreat from choir directors and parish choirs from around the region as well as from as far as Oregon. The retreat will culminate in two pontifical Masses, one to be held at Old St. Mary's on Saturday, August 11, and the other for the 11:00 AM Mass at Sacred Heart on Sunday, August 12.

In order to support this endeavor, fundraisers will be held at both parishes to raise money to send the members of the parish choirs that will be attending this event. The retreat promises to provide profound spiritual and musical growth – perhaps considered a “once in a lifetime” event. Please consider contributing generously to the various fund-raisers that will occur periodically through the year. The first will be a bake sale to be held at Sacred Heart on Sunday, October 29 – Feast of Christ the King in the Extraordinary Form calendar. This bake sale will also include a raffle of a three-dimensional Advent Calendar with the winner to be announced and given the calendar on Sunday, November 26, the last Sunday before Advent begins.

You can also choose to designate monies offered at the Offertory collection to the Sacred Music Retreat. Simply designate your offering as “Retreat Fund” or “Music Retreat” and the money will provide facilitation of internal attendance by our choir members. May God bless your support of this important Catholic Action.
